Vote Independently!

In Kittitas County, registered voters with disabilities are able to exercise their right to vote independently and privately through Accessible Voting Units.

What are Accessible Voting Units?

AVUs are designed to create a simple voting experience for people with:

- blindness or low vision
- deafness or hard of hearing
- physical disabilities
- wheelchair users or limited mobility

Special features of the AVU include:

- Headphones for listening to instructions, candidate names and ballot measures
- A touch screen and/or paddles for selecting his/her choices
- Sip and puff blow tube compatible
- Adjustable to different heights or depths depending on need

AVU Times & Locations

- Available 18 days before the election.
- Located in the Election Control Center, Room 103, Kittitas County Courthouse - 205 W. 5th Ave,
- Election staff are available to assist voters with learning how to use the AVU prior to casting a vote.
